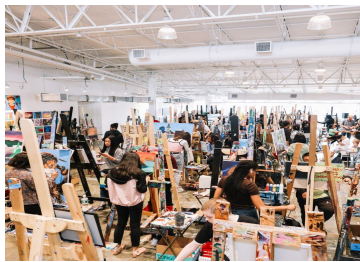

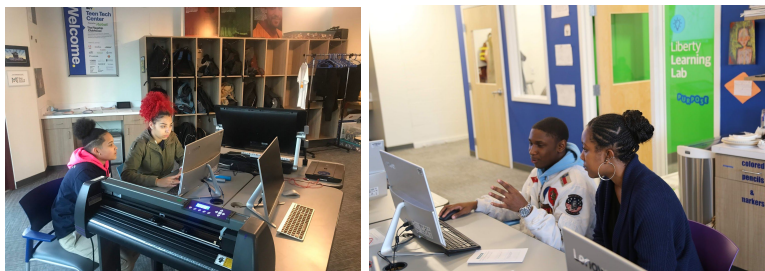
## **THE CLUBHOUSE NETWORK -**
